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## **SECTION 9 EFFECTS FOUND NOT TO BE SIGNIFICANT**

### **9.1 EFFECTS FOUND NOT TO BE SIGNIFICANT DURING THE INITIAL STUDY**

#### **Mineral Resources**

The proposed site is fallow agricultural land. No mineral resources that will be of value to the region or residents of the state have been identified. Additionally, no locally important mineral resource recovery sites in the vicinity of the proposed project have been delineated on a local plan, specific plan, or City or County General Plan. Therefore, there will be no impact.

### **9.2 EFFECTS FOUND NOT TO BE SIGNIFICANT DURING THE EIR PROCESS**

#### **Aesthetics**

There are no scenic vistas or scenic resources in the area. Build-out of the proposed project will be consistent with the surrounding visual character of the area. The project will be required to conform to all City lighting standards therefore mitigating any light or glare issues.

#### **Population and Housing**

The project is intended to accommodate planned regional population growth with the support facilities such as schools, parks, and employment centers to balance community needs. The project site contains two existing residences, and would therefore not displace substantial numbers of existing housing or substantial numbers of people, necessitating the construction of replacement housing elsewhere. Consequently there is no significant impact associated with population and housing.

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
