City Projects Update

El Centro, CA. – May 17, 2019– The City of El Centro is currently in the construction phase of various SB1, Measure D, and Measure P funded projects. The following projects are achieving certain milestones, you have or will be driving on soon.

2018 Street Overlay (SB1 & Measure D funded)

The City of El Centro's 2018 Street Overlay Improvements, along La Brucherie, has completed the placement of the asphalt rubber aggregate membrane (ARAM). Temporary striping and tabbing has been placed to allow traffic along La Brucherie Avenue, from Barbara Worth to Lincoln Avenue. The final surfacing component is scheduled to be placed on Tuesday & Wednesday, May 21 & 22. La Brucherie Avenue will remain open during this work.

Other roadways, which will remain open during final surfacing component, include:

- E. State St., from Fairfield to Dogwood Rd. & Ross Rd., from Dogwood Rd. to City Limit, on Tuesday & Wednesday, May 21 & 22.
- Heil Ave., from Dogwood Rd. to Industry Way & Industry Way, from Heil Ave. to Ross Rd., on Thursday & Friday, May 23 & 24

Traffic striping will be completed the week of June 24.

Public/City Owned Parking Lot Improvements (Measure P funded)

The following parking lots are scheduled to start pavement resurfacing: the El Centro Public Library, located at 1140 N. Imperial Avenue, on Monday, May 20 through Wednesday, May 22. Downtown Public Parking Lots, on Monday, May 20 through Wednesday, May 22. Notices will be provided to downtown businesses, we apologize for the inconvenience. Bucklin Park Parking Lots, on Wednesday, May 22 through Thursday, May 23. The Water Treatment Plant Parking Lot, on Thursday, May 30.

Traffic striping will be completed the week of June 24.

La Brucherie Avenue Widening Improvements Project

The City of El Centro's La Brucherie Avenue Widening Improvements Project is finishing P.C.C. curb returns and sidewalk placement. Based on the pending items, the roadway is considered substantially completed and will be opening to traffic this afternoon, Friday, May 17. The remaining items to complete the project are energizing the street lights,

small portion of sidewalk, fencing, and the placement of the traffic signal poles. These pending items will be completed in the next two to three weeks. Thus, the La Brucherie Avenue & Main Street intersection will open as a four way stop until the signal poles and controller appurtenances are installed and energized. Signal pole foundations and electrical conduits for the signal poles have already been installed.

We will continue to be updating the public and our citizens as we continue to achieve certain milestones in these Projects, and thank you for your enduring patience.
