

NOTICE OF OVERSIGHT BOARD ACTION
CITY OF EL CENTRO
SUCCESSOR AGENCY FOR THE FORMER REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY

LONG RANGE PROPERTY MANAGEMENT PLAN
PURSUANT TO AB 1484

Pursuant to Health and Safety Code Section 34191.5 within six months after receiving a Finding of Completion from the Department of Finance (DOF), a successor agency is required to submit for approval to the Oversight Board and DOF a Long Range Property Management Plan (LRPMP) for the Successor Agency to the former El Centro Redevelopment Agency.

On June 27, 2012, Governor Brown signed into law Assembly Bill 1484 (AB 1484), a budget trailer bill that makes substantial changes to the redevelopment agency dissolution process implemented by Assembly Bill 1X 26. One of the key components of AB 1484 is the requirement that all successor agencies develop a long range property management plan that governs the disposition and use of the former redevelopment agency property.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on October 17, 2013, at 3:00 p.m. the Oversight Board of the Successor Agency to the El Centro Redevelopment Agency will be taking action on the LRPMP prepared for the City of El Centro Successor Agency for the former Redevelopment Agency. The action will be taken at an adjourned regular meeting of the Oversight Board scheduled in the City Council Chambers located at 1275 Main Street, El Centro, CA 92243.
