



"How do I connect to City water or sewer?"

- Ask the Engineering Division about both connection and capacity fees that may apply.
- Fill out the Water / Sewer Connection application and submit it along with any necessary fees to the Engineering Division for processing.
- See cashiers at the Finance Department to open either a water or sewer account as necessary.

"Who does the actual connecting of the line?"

- The Public Works Department will take care of connecting the City's main water line up to your property line (generally, at edge of City sidewalk), and setting a water meter and/or sewer cleanout.
- **The property owner is responsible** for hiring a plumber to connect the City main line to their house.

"How quickly can Public Works begin their work?"

- Depending upon Public Works Department's schedule, it may take between two (2) to six (6) weeks for the work to be completed.

"What if I change my mind about connecting to the City after I've paid the fees?"

- Contact the Engineering Division, as soon as possible, so they may cancel the service order and notify the Public Works Department before they begin their work.
- A request for your reimbursement will promptly be submitted to the Finance Department for payment, once it is confirmed that no work has actually taken place.
